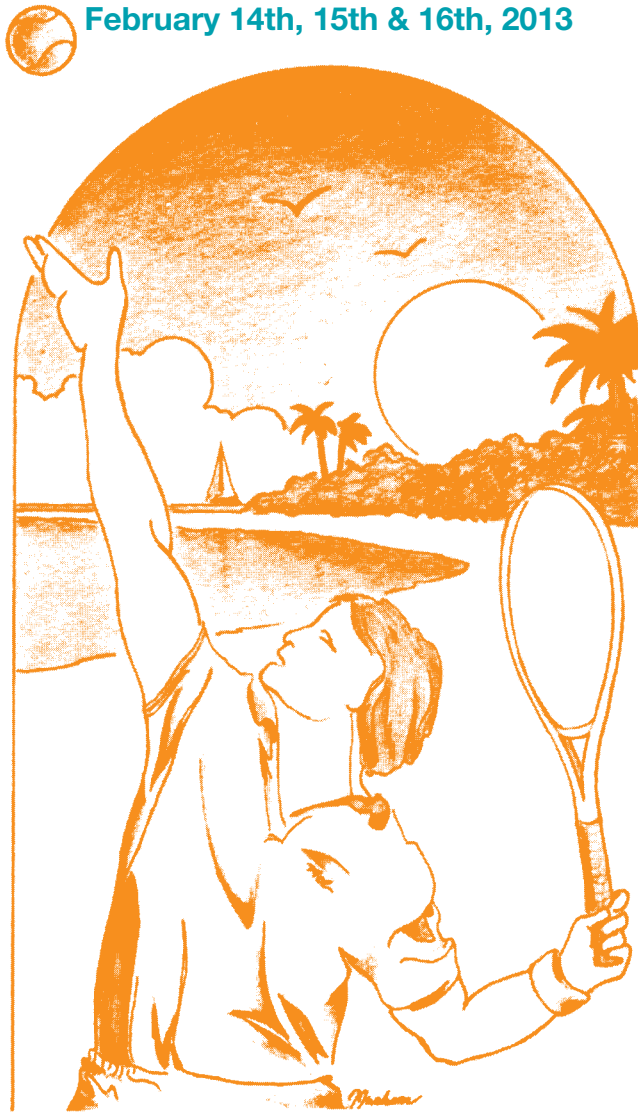

TARGET AUDIENCE

This course is targeted to **practicing ophthalmologists** interested with the latest developments in the diagnosis and management of **vitreo-retinal** and **neuro-ophthalmologic diseases** and **ocular-oncology**.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. Use Spectral Domain OCT advanced imaging techniques for better treatment and follow-up of retinal and optic nerve diseases.
2. Analyze current changes in the timing and surgical management of macular/retinal lesions.
3. Demonstrate an increased understanding of current thoughts on the etiology of AMD and the rational of new therapy.
4. Improve therapeutic approaches based on on-going studies for diabetic retinopathy.
5. Re-enforce the need for accurate diagnosis of anterior ischemic neuropathy and the new methods of therapy.
6. Determine how and when retinal detachments are currently being managed.
7. Appropriately manage retinal vascular disease.
8. Review ever changing applications of anti-VEGF agents.
9. Summarize history and current therapeutic options of pharmacologic vitreolysis.
10. Improve the diagnosis of orbital disease when presenting atypically.

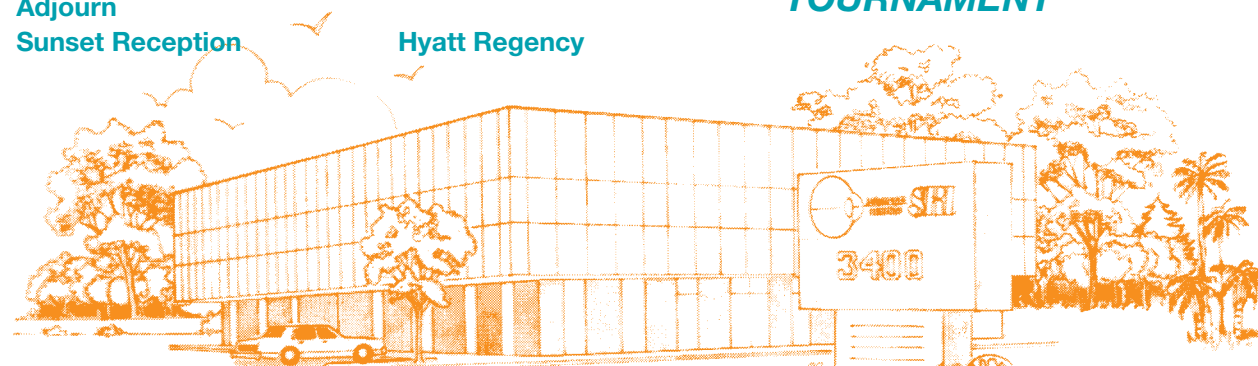
